The Office of the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools may create a new contractors list effective January 1 of each year and may include any contractor's name it desires on the contractors list, but must include, at a minimum, all contractors who have properly provided the District with the required information, either during the calendar year in which the list is valid or during November and December of the prior year. A contractor may have their firm added to the school district's contractors list at any time by providing the required information.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Senate Bill 854 became effective July 1, 2014, and requires contractors to register with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) prior to bidding and performing work on public works projects for construction, alteration, demolition, installation or repair work greater than \$25,000 or maintenance work greater than \$15,000. Contractors are required to comply with all rules pertaining to enforcement of prevailing wage requirements by DIR.
