## FRESNO COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

**MINUTES** November 20, 2008 CALL TO ORDER President Thomas called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance to the flag, followed by an inspirational reading by Armen Bacon. Member Cederquist moved to approve the November 20, 2008 agenda; seconded by Member AGENDA Clyde; motion carried unanimously. Member Clyde moved to approve the minutes of the October 16, 2008 Board meeting; seconded by Minutes Member Cederquist; motion carried unanimously.
