Employee of the Month April 2014

Mary Ann Cusator was selected as the April 2014 Employee of the Month. Mary Ann Cusator has spent her entire career observing natural cause and effect. And through her dedication, she has been a catalyst for front-line development at the local and statewide levels in programs benefitting our youngest learners. Prior to joining FCOE's Early Care and Education department in 2002, Mary Ann was a classroom teacher in both elementary and intermediate schools in Clovis Unified School District. The bulk of her teaching was spent in 5<sup>th</sup> grade, that pivotal year as children transition from kids to pre-teens.

"It was very clear the students whose moms had read to them. The ones who had rich life experiences," said Mary Ann, who recognized even then the life-long impact that education before age 5 can have on a child. "The ones who struggled to catch up, I had to meet them where they were and pull them forward."

It is that struggle she believes could eventually be unnecessary by continuing to provide direct services, support and professional growth to those in the trenches – the early care and education teachers in both private and public settings.

Her resume of creating successful programs is abundant, including assisting the then Deputy Superintendent Jim Yovino in 2007 by raising the awareness of early care and education through successful partnerships with agencies and institutions of higher education.
